② Well proved but lack clinical verification

③ Possess only fragmentary pathogeneses

④ Derived surely by ab us in morbis

3rd edition - 1888  
→ Made to make it as a complete.  
→ 4 less important, Hennedy & Castor Euphorbia,  
Opuntia, Cartonium removed and 5  
important Hennedy (Acetic acid, Crocetina,  
Anguria, Caubolic acid, Valariana) added.

4th edition - 1896

→ Thorough revision to make it complete  
without addition or omission.
