-Repertorium Homoeopathicum Syntheticeum

- ① It is a product of continuous teamwork with superb technology.
- ② It is a printed version of RADAR computer program.
- ③ It has set a new standard by continuous verification by users and adding list of useful information.
- ④ It is the latest among all the repertories.
- ⑤ It was written by Dr. Friedrich Schroyer.
- ⑥ It is an enlarged version of the sixth American edition of Kent repertory. It contains all its rubric and remedies. It has been enlarged qualitatively for easy reference.
- ⑦ They needed a continuous developing repertory, so in 18th and 19th century, a teamwork started collecting information along with the cooperation of many homoeopaths. Then they made a computer program called Reclian. On the request of many homoeopaths Synthesia was made in print.

## Synthesis 1: (Special features)

- ① Sources are verified and mentioned at the end of each medicine.
  - ② Rubrics are made into "Symptom Journal" which is clearly readable.
  - ③ Kent's arrangement of STM are followed.
  - ④ Clinical rubrics were renamed according to modern nomenclature.
  - ⑤ Contains more than 2000 remedies.
  - ⑥ Thousands of cross-reference and synonyms in kind.
  - ⑦ A New set of list of remedy abbreviation.
  - ⑧ Addition of 235,000 more than original Kent's repertory.
- It follows the plan and construction, arrangement of rubrics as Kent's repertory. General to particular is followed. Method of representation is Kent. When the case is rich in general and characteristic particular it can be represented in Synthesis.

- ① Published in 2001.
- ② Provides quality of information than quantity.
- ③ Many new proving integrated.
- ④ No. of Medicines - 2277.
- ⑤ 392,000 additions.
- ⑥ Modification of rubrics are made.

Synthesia 9.0 / 91.

- ① Restructuring of the subunits are made
- ② Information from Boger and Boenninghaus are added.
- ③ A personal chapter, to add own symptoms
- ④ Neck, Urinary Organs, Male & Female Sex / Genitalia - 4 & 2 chapters.
- ⑤ Repertories of Bowditch and Phatak are integrated.
- ⑥ Information on Magnets are added.
- ⑦ Down arrow ↓ indicator the remedy is copied from similar subunit.
- ⑧ Black dot • indicator the remedy is added from a more recent author or less known author.
- ⑨ 4497 remedy abbreviation and 2373 is used.

In Radar 10, the new computer version of Synthesia Treasure edition is available.

It contains the corrections notes by Kent in his personal copy and 223 handwritten additions from his copy of Guiding Symptoms by Hering.

It follows the plan of STME L.D. <sup>Location</sup> → <sup>Description</sup> in pair subunit.

## Essential Synthesis

- It was published by Dr. Fredrik Schreyers in 2007 after being inspired by the slogan "Returning to Hartmann".
- It is based on original version of Kent's repository.
- In Essential Synthesis all the essential information are retained and some unreliable information has been removed (Eg. Author's references reduced; Remedies from 23<sup>13</sup> to 1990 reduced).
- Even if there is less information, there is more important information.
- It can be also said it is the addition version of Synthesis 9.1.9.
- It comes with a motto "less is more".
